I am sending you a picture of our chapel. The project is almost completed but we have some special needs.

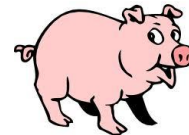
- **Windows and glass \$5,000**

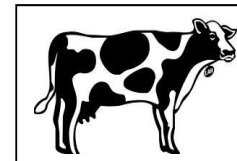
**From Fr. Wiseman Msemwa, O.

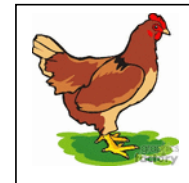


**Buy Us!!!!**
