Philstar.com reports:

More than 12,000 people displaced by the massive Nov. 8, 2013 typhoon Haiyan/Yolanda have made it to the capital of Manila. Most are with relatives; those with no family here are in shelters. Many have no idea how or where to rebuild their lives. It was one of the most powerful recorded storms to make landfall.

It tore through the center of the Philippines, where many people were just beginning to recover from an earthquake.

Dagupan City where our Fr. Alvin Platon is working and Tacloban, the most hit city, are 500 miles apart. Dagupan, 107 miles north of Manila, did not receive any typhoon damage.

Fr. Alvin was interviewed by Philstar.com about his "March of the Saints" with hundreds of parishioners from St. John Evangelist parish in Dagupan City. "The alternative celebration is to bring back the holiness, the sacredness of the celebration which is All Saints Day: It's also a costume party, a celebration for children and people if they would like to dress up as saints to remove the fear of Halloween," he added.

Other parishes would have similar celebrations where children would dress up as saints.
